# 7. AMENDMENTS TO URBAN RENEWAL AREAS

a) Consider **resolution** setting a date for consultation and a date for public hearing on Amendment No. 9 to the Coralville Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Plan for the Coralville Urban Renewal Area.

<u>Note:</u> This amendment will add 905 5<sup>th</sup> Street and the 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue Roundabout project to the Coralville Urban Renewal Plan. The consultation will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, March 13, 2020 and the public hearing will be Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

b) Consider resolution setting a date for consultation and a date for public hearing on the proposed Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Plan for the 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue Urban Renewal Area (Amendment No. 9).

<u>Note:</u> This amendment will add right of ways and projects for extensions of Redhawk and University Parkway to the 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue Urban Renewal Plan. The consultation will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, March 13, 2020 and the public hearing will be Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

### 8. BONDS ~ PUBLIC HEARINGS

a) Consider **resolution** setting the date for a public hearing on proposal to enter into a Road Use Tax Revenue Loan Agreement and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$5,000,000.00.

Note: This financing (Series 2020A) is a Road Use Tax Revenue Bond issue to finance a portion of the street projects on East 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and East 9<sup>th</sup> Street. The security for the issue will be state Road Use Tax revenues. The intended repayment source is Mall & Highway 6 TIF revenues.

> b) Consider **resolution** to fix a date for a public hearing on General Obligation Essential Corporate Purpose Loan Agreements.

**Note:** This financing (Series 2020E through 2020H) will pay costs related to projects on 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, in addition to refinancing prior bond issues (2014C, 2015A, 2015B, 2016D-2, and 2017D-2). The repayment source is the City's debt service property tax levy, 12th Avenue TIF revenues and Mall & Highway 6 TIF revenues.

> c) Consider resolution to fix a date for a public hearing on the issuance of not to exceed \$8.500.000.00 Urban Renewal Tax Increment Revenue Bonds.

**Note:** This financing (Series 2020B) will pay costs related to a project on 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue, in addition to refinancing a prior bond issue (2011F). The repayment source is 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue TIF revenues.

# 9. INTERIOR DRAINAGE MODELING - PUMP STATION NO. 7

Note: This agreement is for the creation of an interior drainage model for the area served by Stormwater Pump Station No. 7 and is not to exceed \$28,300.00.
