- 6. LOT 2, DOVETAIL ESTATES, PART NINE
 - a) ORDINANCE NO. 2020-1002 An ordinance amending the Coralville Zoning Ordinance, the same being Ordinance No. 664, as previously amended, rezoning certain property located within the corporate limits of the City of Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa and generally known as Lot 2, Dovetail Estates Part Nine, from C-PUD 1, Commercial Planned Unit Development One District, to C-PUD 2, Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District, for 2nd consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This will rezone Lot 2, Dovetail Estates – Part Nine to Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District in order to build an 8,926 sq. ft. single-story commercial use building with two tenant spaces.

7. CHAPTER 657A (ABANDONED BUILDINGS)

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2020-1003 An ordinance regarding the applicability of Chapter 657A of the Code of lowa, for 2nd consideration.

Note: In 2019 the Iowa General Assembly passes a law requiring the City to codify that Chapter 657A (Abandoned Buildings) applies in the City.

8. BONDS

a) Consider resolution authorizing and approving a Loan Agreement, awarding the sale, providing for the issuance of General Obligation Bonds, Series 2020E, and providing for the levy of taxes to pay the same.

<u>Note:</u> This financing refinances the 2015A issue, as well as financing \$1.4 million of new street improvements. This issue will be repaid from a combination of debt service property tax revenues and Mall & Highway 6 TIF revenues.

b) Consider **resolution** authorizing and approving a Loan Agreement, awarding the sale, providing for the issuance of Taxable General Obligation Bonds, Series 2020F, and proving for the levy of taxes to pay the same.

<u>Note:</u> This financing refinances the 2015B and 2016D-2 issues. This issue will be repaid from Mall & Highway 6 TIF area revenues.

c) Consider **resolution** to fix a date for a public hearing on a Loan Agreement in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00.

<u>Note:</u> This finances the green stormwater infrastructure improvements included in the East 2nd Avenue project. It will involve a State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan and forgiveness of a portion of principal under an lowa Department of Natural Resources grant. The financing will be repaid through the stormwater fund, with a transfer of TIF revenues in from the Mall & Highway 6 TIF fund. The public hearing will be May 26, 2020.

9. UNION CONTRACT

a) Consider **resolution** approving an Agreement with AFSCME Local 183, Council 61, representing Public Works, Parks and Recreation employees effective July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022.

Note: This agreement is for two years which will run through June 30, 2022. This allows the Public Works, Parks & Recreation and the Police Union contracts to be negotiated at the same time for July 1, 2022.

10. VARIOUS LOTS IN THE SUMMIT HILLS ADDITION

a) Consider **resolution** approving the disposal of an interest in real property, that property being various lots in the Summit Hills Addition, Coralville, Iowa.

<u>Note</u>: Blue Sky Developers are purchasing Lots 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 109 and 112, Summit Hills Addition and Lots 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A, 6A, 7A, 11A, 12A, 13A, 14A, 15A, 16A, 17A, 18A, 19A, 20A, 23A, 24A, 25A and 26A of the replat of a portion of the Summit Hills Addition from the City of Coralville in order to build single family homes with two car garages on each lot. The public hearing was held March 24, 2020.

Note: This is for the purchase of 820 Hughes Street for \$119,100.00, in order to redevelop it.

Note: This is for the purchase of 824 Hughes Street for \$89,800.00, in order to redevelop it.

12. LOTS 1 AND 2, THE BLUFFS AT BROWN DEER

a) Consider resolution clarifying the grantees for Lots 1 and 2, The Bluffs at Brown Deer, Coralville, Iowa.

<u>Note</u>: This is for title purposes, the buyer has requested a resolution clarifying the grantee for each lot to be placed on record.

13. ASSIGNMENT AMENDMENT TO LEASE

 Consider resolution approving an Assignment of Lease from Louie's Wine Dive Coralville to 901 IRL, LLC.

Note: This Assignment of an Amendment to Lease will turn over the lease for Louie's Wine Dive in the lowa River Landing to 901 IRL, LLC who will open a new type of restaurant in the space.

b) Consider **resolution** approving an Assignment Amendment and Release of Guaranty of Lease with Taco Dirty to Me, LLC.

Note: This Assignment Amendment to Lease will turn over the lease for Fuzzy's Taco's in the lowa River Landing to Taco Dirty to Me, LLC. Taco Dirty to Me, LLC will also exercise the option to extend the lease to June 30, 2027.

14. IOWA RIVER LANDING JOINT COMMUNICATION CONDUIT AGREEMENT

a) Consider **resolution** approving an Agreement with MidAmerican Energy Company for a joint communication conduit in the Iowa River Landing.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement allows MidAmerican Energy Company to install fiber optic cable from their 1st Avenue substation to a pole near the northeast corner of the lowa River Landing by allowing them to make use of an existing City owned 2" conduit along the lowa River Trail behind the Marriott and conduit extensions at the north and south ends of the existing conduit. The agreement establishes MidAmerican's ownership of the northern extension of the conduit and grants them joint use of the existing conduit and the southern extension both of which will be owner by the City of Coralville.

15. BROWN DEER GOLF CLUB GOLF MAINTENANCE COORDINATOR AGREEMENT

a) Consider **resolution** approving that certain Brown Deer Golf Club Golf Maintenance Coordinator Agreement for with Tom Palachek for the Brown Deer Golf Course.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement for the Golf Maintenance Coordinator is similar to the Golf Pro positions with a salary base amount and a percentage based on play or use; a health insurance stipend; and a cell phone stipend. This agreement covers April 13, 2020 through December 31, 2020.
