- a) Public hearing on an Application to the Iowa Economic Development Authority for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funding the purchase of Coralville Community Food Pantry Commercial Kitchen Equipment.

<u>Note</u>: This is for constructing stormwater improvements on 5th Avenue north of 7th Street to address longstanding drainage problems in the backyards of 711, 713 and 715 5th Avenue and for storm sewer needed for the redevelopment of City-owned properties along 4th Avenue Place.

8. ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT

a) Consider **resolution** approving an Engineering Services Agreement with Veenstra & Kimm, Inc. for bridge inspection services.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement is for testing two vehicular bridges to determine recommended maintenance and estimated remaining bridge service life for not to exceed \$18,283.00. The bridges are on Deer Creek Road over Clear Creek and Holiday Road just east of 12th Avenue.

b) Consider **resolution** approving an Engineering Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc. for floodwall review and recommendations to achieve FEMA certification.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement is for reviewing the floodwall system located south of Clear Creek between the lowa River and Iowa Interstate Railroad in order to produce recommendations and cost estimates to improve the floodwall and receive FEMA certification and accreditation resulting in a mapped flood risk reduction and lower insurance costs for not to exceed \$19,700.00.

9. FOREVERGREEN HEIGHTS, PLAT 1

a) Consider **resolution** partially accepting public improvements constructed on Lots 1-50 and 63-70, Forevergreen Heights, Plat 1, Coralville, Iowa.

<u>Note:</u> This partial acceptance includes the storm sewer, sanitary sewer and water main constructed by Maxwell Construction, Inc. and the paving constructed by Streb Construction Co., Inc. for Lots 1 through 50 and 63 through 70 in Forevergreen Heights, Plat 1 excluding sidewalks pursuant to the Subdivider's Agreement.
