#### 9. FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET - MAXIMUM LEVY

 Consider resolution setting a public hearing date on the total maximum property tax dollars for the Fiscal Year 2023. **Note:** This will set the maximum levy hearing on the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget as required by the State of Iowa. This hearing is an additional step in the budget process created by legislation passed during the 2019 legislative session. The public hearing is February 8, 2022.
