#### 6. LOT 2, REDHAWK SUBDIVISION, PART THREE

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1001 An ordinance amending the Coralville Zoning Ordinance, the same being Ordinance No. 2020-1009, as previously amended, rezoning certain property located within the corporate limits of the City of Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa and generally known as Lot 2, Redhawk Subdivision, Part Three, from C-PUD-1, Commercial Planned Unit Development One District, to C-PUD 2, Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District, for 2<sup>nd</sup> consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This will rezone a .06-acre parcel to a Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District in order to build two multi-tenant commercial buildings.

## 7. BONDS ~ PUBLIC HEARING

- a) Consider **resolution** authorizing and approving a Loan Agreement awarding the sale, providing for the issuance of General Obligation Corporate Purpose and Refunding Bonds, Series 2022A and providing for the levy of taxes to pay the same, amendment to Resolution 2022-28.
- **b)** Consider **resolution** authorizing and approving a bank proposal and awarding the sale of Taxable General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2022B.

<u>Note</u>: These legal proceedings contain the final interest rates and prices for refinancing nine bond issues for interest rate savings. The repayment source is the City's debt service property tax levy, Oakdale TIF, 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue TIF and Mall & Highway 6 TIF.

# 8. UNION CONTRACT

**a)** Consider **resolution** approving an Agreement with AFSCME Local 183, Council 61, representing Transit employees effective July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025.

Note: This agreement is for three years which will run through June 30, 2025.

# 9. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

**Note:** The Procurement Standards have changed so the City needs to adopt the amended Procurement Policy and approve the Certification of Compliance CDBG Procurement Standards for the Community Development Block Grant (COVID-19) Program Contract No. 20-CVN-025 for the \$100,000.00 to purchase the Coralville Community Food Pantry Commercial Kitchen Equipment.

## 10. FOREVERGREEN HEIGHTS AND SCANLON FARMS SOUTH RIDGE

a) Consider **resolution** approving Amendment No. 1 to the Development Agreement for Forevergreen Heights and Scanlon Farms South Ridge.

<u>Note</u>: This amends the original Development Agreement to require the developer to construct the North Liberty Road/Forevergreen Road roundabout at its sole cost and the City will construct the Dubuque Street and Forevergreen Road Roundabout at its sole cost.

# 11. FOREVERGREEN ROAD AND NORTH LIBERTY ROAD ROUNDABOUT

a) Consider **resolution** approving a 28E Agreement with Johnson County regarding the construction of the Forevergreen Road and North Liberty Road Roundabout.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement covers the respective City and County duties and costs associated with the construction of the Forevergreen Road and North Liberty Road Roundabout on City and County right-of-ways.
