<u>Note</u>: This is for renovating the fitness center and office space at the Hyatt Regency Coralville Hotel & Conference Center.

6. CLEAR CREEK AMANA NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL 2024

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1013 An ordinance amending the Coralville Zoning Ordinance, the same being Ordinance No. 2020-1009, as previously amended, rezoning certain property located within the corporate limits of the City of Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa and generally known as Parcel Number 0626401003, from R-1, Single-Family Residential District, to C-PUD 2, Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District, for 2nd consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This rezoning to a Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District will allow the Clear Creek Amana Community School District to build a new elementary school in the West Land Use Area.

7. 10TH AVENUE URBAN RENEWAL PLAN

a) Consider **resolution** setting a public hearing on the 10th Avenue Urban Revitalization Plan.

<u>Note</u>: This is for the abatement portion of the development agreement for the 413 10th Avenue project. The public hearing will be December 13, 2022.

8. URBAN RENEWAL AREAS

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1014 An ordinance amending Ordinance Nos. 608, 707, 2001-942, 2006-1052, 2013-1009, 2014-1007, 2017-1017 and 2020-1014 providing that general property taxes levied and collected each year on all property located within the Coralville Urban Renewal Project Area in the City of Coralville, County of Johnson, State of Iowa, by and for the benefit of the State of Iowa, City of Coralville, County of Johnson, Iowa City Community School District, and other taxing districts, be paid to a special fund for payment of principal and interest on Ioans, monies advanced to and indebtedness, including bonds issued or to be issued, incurred by said City in connection with said Urban Renewal Redevelopment Project, for 1st consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This ordinance sets the base value of 3 properties in the Coralville Urban Renewal Area (Oakdale) on Crosspark Road. They are the car wash, auto parts store and a multi-tenant building.

b) Ordinance No. 2022-1015 An ordinance amending Ordinance Nos. 651, 706, 96-749, 96-777, 2003-969, 2013-1008, 2014-1011, 2015-1017, 2016-1019 and 2017-1015 providing that General Property Taxes levied and collected each year on all property located within the 12th Avenue Urban Renewal Project Area in the City of Coralville, County of Johnson, State of Iowa, by and for the benefit of the State of Iowa, City of Coralville, County of Johnson, Iowa City Community School District and other Taxing Districts, be paid to a special fund for payment of principal and interest on Ioans, monies advanced to and indebtedness, including bonds issued or to be issued, incurred by said City in connection with said Urban Renewal Redevelopment Project for 1st consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This ordinance sets the base value of the 413 10th Avenue project property in the 12th Avenue Urban Renewal Area.

9. AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO PURCHASE AGREEMENT

a) Consider **resolution** approving and ratifying Amendment No. 2 to that certain Purchase Agreement with Colony, Inc.

<u>Note</u>: This amendment is for the last 7.5-acre parcel to be purchased by the City using Resource Enhancement and Protection ("REAP") funds. This last REAP grant award was not known at the time of the original purchase agreement.

10. 5TH STREET PROJECT - 12TH AVENUE TO 20TH AVENUE

a) Consider **resolution** approving a Federal Aid Agreement with the Iowa Department of Transportation for the 5th Street Project – 12th Avenue to 20th Avenue.

<u>Note</u>: This agreement with the Iowa Department of Transportation is for \$1,650,000.00 in federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds for construction of the 5th Street improvements between 12th Avenue and 20th Avenue.
