6. CIVCO PROJECT URBAN RENEWAL PLAN

a) Consider resolution resetting a date for consultation and a date for a public hearing on the proposed Amendment No. 15 to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Mall and Highway 6 Urban Renewal Area.

<u>Note</u>: This is for the abatement portion of the development agreement for the CIVCO project. The public hearing scheduled for today needs to be postponed until August 8, 2023. The consultation will be 2:00 PM on Monday, July 24, 2023.

7. PARCEL LOCATED AT ACORN DRIVE AND JAMES STREET ADJACENT TO JACOBS CLEAR CREEK SEVENTH SUBDIVISION ~ PUBLIC HEARING

- a) Community Development Report.
- b) Planning & Zoning Commission Report.
- c) Public hearing on amending the Land Use Map for a portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, and a portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, both of Township 80 North, Range 7 West, of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa from Regional Commercial Use to Industrial Use.
- d) ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1009 An ordinance amending the Coralville Community Plan to reflect certain property generally known as a portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, and a portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, both of Township 80 North, Range 7 West, of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa to be designated Industrial Use in place of Regional Commercial Use, for 1st consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This land use amendment is for a 11.26-acre parcel located at the west end of Acorn Drive and James Street adjacent to Jacobs Clear Creek Seventh Subdivision for a proposed 80,000 square foot light-industrial facility with spaces for an office, light assembly, fabrication and distribution.

8. LOT 3, REDHAWK SUBDIVISION, PART TWO

- a) ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1007 An ordinance amending the Coralville Zoning Ordinance, the same being Ordinance No. 2020-1009, as previously amended, rezoning certain property located within the corporate limits of the City of Coralville, Johnson County, Iowa and generally known as Lot 3, Redhawk Subdivision, Part Two, from C-PUD 1, Commercial Planned Development One District, to C-PUD 2, Commercial Planned Unit Development Two District, for 3rd and final consideration.

Note: This rezoning is for a 2,337 square foot stand-alone drive-thru restaurant on a 1.88-acre site.

<u>Note</u>: This is an option to purchase Lot 4, Iowa River Landing, Part Two north of the West Parking Ramp on or before January 31, 2024.

11. PURCHASE AGREEMENT

a) Consider **resolution** approving a Purchase Agreement for 612 4th Avenue, Coralville, Iowa.

<u>Note</u>: This property has a duplex that is currently leased until April 2024 at a rate of \$1,510.00 per month. The City will continue leasing the property until it is needed for redevelopment. This purchase will allow combining this lot with City owned 614 4th Avenue and removal 614's driveway. The purchase price is \$170,000.00.

12. COLONY FEN EROSION AND DEWATERING CORRECTION PROJECT

<u>Note</u>: The is a \$73,600.00 grant supporting the purchase of recycling carts and education and outreach efforts with the goal of improving and enhancing the curbside recycling program.

<u>Note</u>: This gives the Director of Finance approval to transfer unassigned funds above the required minimum of 35% of operating expenses in the General Fund to other funds currently below their required minimum of 25% of operating expenses. Fund minimums are set by the City's financial policy.

a) Consider **resolution** approving an Amendment to the 28E Agreement for Paratransit Services between the City of Coralville and Johnson County.

<u>Note</u>: This Amended 28E Agreement is for Johnson County SEATS to provide a one-month extension ending July 31, 2023 while a new agreement for paratransit services is being negotiated.
