7. CLEAR CREEK STREAM MITIGATION BANK CONSTRUCTION ~ PUBLIC HEARING

<u>Note</u>: The Clear Creek Stream Bank Construction includes improvements of Reaches 1 & 3 and Becky's Creek regions of Clear Creek.

8. 5TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS – 12TH AVENUE TO 20th AVENUE ~ PUBLIC HEARING

<u>Note</u>: This project will improve 5th Street between 12th Avenue and 20th Avenue. This project will no longer include the water main improvements which were bid out as a separate project in hopes of getting a better bid. Acceptance of bids, contract and bond documents are subject Iowa Department of Transportation concurrence.

9. MORRISON CREEK DRAINAGEWAY PROJECT

<u>Note</u>: This project built a trail crossing the Morrison Creek drainageway north of 8th Street and connected the trails on both sides of the drainageway. Pay Application #3 is for the \$4,300.00 retainage to be paid 30-days after it is approved.

10. URBAN RENEWAL AREAS

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1014 An ordinance amending Ordinance Nos. 608, 707, 2001-942, 2006-1052, 2013-1009, 2014-1007, 2017-1017, 2020-1014 and 2022-1014 providing that general property taxes levied and collected each year on all property located within the Coralville Urban Renewal Project Area in the City of Coralville, County of Johnson, State of Iowa, by and for the benefit of the State of Iowa, City of Coralville, County of Johnson, Iowa City Community School District, and other taxing districts, be paid to a special fund for payment of principal and interest on loans, monies advanced to and indebtedness, including bonds issued or to be issued, incurred by said City in connection with said Urban Renewal Redevelopment Project, for 2nd consideration.

Note: This ordinance sets the base value of Lot 7, Coral Ridge Commerce Park Phase 7 in the Coralville Urban Renewal Area (Oakdale) on Crosspark Road. This is the lot with Barrett's.

11. CONSTRUCTION SITE RUNOFF AND SEDIMENT CONTROL ORDINANCE

a) ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1015 An ordinance amending Chapter 159 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coralville (2011), as previously amended, regarding construction site runoff and sediment control, for 1st consideration.

<u>Note</u>: These changes are in response to United States Environmental Protection Agency comments from a recent audit of the Construction Site Runoff and Sediment Control Ordinance.

12. STREET FINANCE REPORT

Note: This report itemizes the allocation of funds used to construct, repair and maintain City streets.
