- 5. HATE CRIMES ORDINANCE
 - a) ORDINANCE NO. 2024-1001 An ordinance amending the City of Coralville Code of Ordinances (2011), as previously amended, to include a Hate Crimes Ordinance for 3rd and final consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This ordinance will allow for hate crime enhancements pursuant to City ordinance. This ordinance mirror's ordinances passed by lowa City and North Liberty except, like all Coralville ordinances, it does not mandate jail sentences for prosecution of simple misdemeanor offenses.

6. CLEAR CREEK STREAM MITIGATION BANK CONSTRUCTION

- a) Bid Report.
- **b)** Consider **resolution** accepting bids and awarding the Contract for the Clear Creek Stream Mitigation Bank Construction.
- **c)** Consider **resolution** approving the Contract and bond documents for the Clear Creek Stream Mitigation Bank Construction.

<u>Note</u>: The Clear Creek Stream Bank Construction includes improvements of Reaches 1 & 3 and Becky's Creek regions of Clear Creek.

7. GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY MODELING

a) Consider **resolution** approving a Proposal with Innovative Groundwater Solutions, LLC for Groundwater Sustainability Modeling in the Silurian and Jordan Aquifers.

Note: This proposal will create a locally scaled models for both the Silurian and Jordan Aquifers to guide future strategies to expand total water source capacity in Coralville and is not to exceed \$31,900.00.

8. WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY - ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECTS

a) Consider **resolution** accepting quotations and approving the proposal from West Branch Roofing for the Wastewater Treatment Facility Roof Replacement Projects.

<u>Note</u>: This proposal will replace roofs on the Sludge Building and SBR Building at the Wastewater Treatment Plant and is not to exceed \$118,986.00.

9. KEMPF LIFT STATION ABANDONMENT

 a) Consider resolution setting a public hearing date for the Kempf Lift Station Abandonment.

<u>Note</u>: The sanitary sewer lines served by Kempf Lift Station have been hooked up to a new gravitational sewer line so the lift station can be abandoned. The public hearing will be February 13, 2024.

10. WEST LAND USE CENTRAL TRUNK SEWER PHASE 2

a) Consider resolution setting a public hearing date for the West Land Use Central Trunk Sewer Phase 2.

<u>Note</u>: Phase 2 extends the West Land Use Central Trunk Sewer system to the north and east of where the Phase 1 ended. The public hearing will be February 13, 2024.

11. 12TH AVENUE URBAN RENWAL PLAN AMENDMENT

a) Consider resolution setting a date for consultation and date of public hearing for on a proposed Amendment No. 11 to Amended and Restated Urban Renewal Plan for the 12th Avenue Renewal Area.

<u>Note</u>: This amendment is required to use tax increment financing to pay for the 5th Street Improvements – 12th Avenue to 20th Avenue. Consultation will be held on February 12, 2024 and the public hearing will be February 27, 2024.

12. HIGHWAY 6 URBAN REVITALIZATION PLAN

a) Consider resolution setting a public hearing on the Highway 6 Urban Revitalization Plan.

<u>Note</u>: This is the first step in the process to allow for tax abatement for a development on two parcels directly west of the Lowe's Home Center on Highway 6. The public hearing will be February 27, 2024.
