5. OAKDALE BOULEVARD FORCEMAIN PROJECT ~ PUBLIC HEARINGS

- **a)** Public hearing on an Environmental Information Document for the Oakdale Boulevard Forcemain Project.
- **b) Motion** to receive approve and place on file an Environmental Information Document for the Oakdale Boulevard Forcemain Project.

<u>Note</u>: A public hearing on the Environmental Information Document is a requirement to receive State Revolving Funds for the Oakdale Boulevard Forcemain Project.

- c) Public hearing on the plans, specifications, estimate of cost and form of contract for the Oakdale Boulevard Forcemain Project.
- **d)** Consider **resolution** approving the plans, specifications, estimate of cost and form of contract; ordering bids, setting a date for the receiving of bids; and directing posting of the bid letting; all for the for the Oakdale Boulevard Forcemain Project.

<u>Note</u>: This is for construction of a new forcemain from Brown Deer No. 4 Lift Station west along Oakdale Boulevard, through the 12th Avenue intersection to Oakdale Road, then to the west end on Oakdale Road connection to the existing gravity trunk sewer. Bids are due April 2, 2024.

6. WEST LAND USE CENTRAL TRUNK SEWER PHASE 2

- a) Bid Report.
- **b)** Consider **resolution** accepting bids and awarding the Contract for the West Land Use Central Trunk Sewer Phase 2, pending notice of funding eligibility from INDR.

8. CLEAR CREEK TRAIL CONNECTION PROJECT
