<u>Note</u>: This piece of equipment will be used by the Forestry program for timber stand improvement work and to keep invasives under control in Coralville woodlands and it will be used to maintain flood berms, some of the stormwater bio cells, the Clear Creek Stream Mitigation project along with snow removal operations and other project work.

10. CORALVILLE WEST PART FOUR, LOT 1

Readings are condensed in order to meet the filing deadline at the end of the month.

13. AMENDMENT NO. 18 MALL AND HIGHWAY 6 URBAN RENEWAL PLAN

a) Consider resolution setting a date for consultation and a date for a public hearing on the proposed Amendment No. 18 to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Mall and Highway 6 Urban Renewal Area.

<u>Note</u>: This Amendment No. 18 for the mixed-use project referred to as Gather lowa will allow for the rebate of incremental tax revenues to the Developer. The public hearing will be December 10, 2024 and the consultation will be held on Monday, December 2, 2024.

Note: The City Council is required by HF2640 to formally approve by motion the filing of an Annual Urban Renewal Report with the Iowa Department of Management.

<u>Note</u>: The Director of Finance needs Council approval by resolution to transfer reserve funds in Fund 200 into specific funds from which bonds are paid (e.g., Mall TIF, Oakdale TIF) to allow a rating agency to see the cash for its intended purpose which is to be available for debt service payments. Also, the transfer to the IRL Project Fund that was approved on June 25, 2025 need to be revised to facilitate the movement of cash to the Hotel Fund to pay principal and interest on Hotel debt service.

16. CORAL RIDGE MALL WELCOME CENTER SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT
