<u>Note</u>: This is to finance costs of extending, widening, improving, constructing, and repairing streets, water, sewer, flood protection/remediation projects, and other infrastructure improvements. These loan agreements are not to exceed \$1,700,000.00.

15. AMENDMENT TO GAS & ELECTRIC FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS

- a) Consider ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1003 granting to MidAmerican Energy Company, its successors and assigns, the right and non-exclusive franchise to acquire, construct, erect, maintain and operate in the City of Coralville, Iowa an electric system and communications facilities and to furnish and sell electric energy to the City and its inhabitants and authorizing the City to collect franchise fees for a period of 20 years, for 3rd and final consideration.
- b) Consider ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1004 granting to MidAmerican Energy Company, its successors and assigns, the right and non-exclusive franchise to acquire, construct, erect, maintain and operate in the City of Coralville, lowa, a natural gas system and to furnish and sell natural gas to the City and its inhabitants and authorizing the City to collect franchise fees for a period of 20 years, for 3rd and final consideration.
- c) Consider **ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1005** amending Section 111B.17 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coralville increasing the franchise fee for the sales of electricity by Linn County Rural Electric Cooperative to 2%, for **3**rd **and final consideration**.

Note: A public hearing is required prior to amending franchise agreements and increasing the franchise fees on gas and electrical facilities sold by MidAmerican Energy Company and Linn County REC from 1% to 2%.

16. WEST LAND USE CENTRAL TRUNK SEWER PHASE 1

- **a) Motion** approving Pay Estimate #13 to **Maxwell Construction**, **Inc**. for the West Land Use Central Trunk Sewer Phase 1: \$6.407.43.

<u>Note</u>: This is for the completion of a trunk sewer from the Clear Creek Amana Community School District new elementary school site to the northwest corner of Highway 6 and Lucas Avenue. The retainage due in 30 days is \$146,225.51. (A final pay estimate for the retainage will be on the June 10th Agenda because of State Revolving Fund (SRF) requirements.)

17. CORALVILLE YOUTH SPORTS PARK PROJECT - PHASE III

<u>Note</u>: All bids came in higher than the engineer's estimate of \$1,584,000.00 so discussions between staff, contractors and the consultant it is recommended to reject the bids and work with the consultant to make value engineering decisions and determine if splitting the project into a grading and civil improvements project and ballfield construction project will result in lower bids in late summer or fall.

18. CLEAR CREEK STREAM MITIGATION BANK FILL DIRT AGREEMENT

<u>Note</u>: This grant is for Gather Iowa, a development south of 2nd Street (Highway 6) and West of 1st Avenue with the City pledging in-kind support of \$1,000.00 per residential unit for up to 185 units.
