- c) ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1015 An ordinance amending Chapter 22.03 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coralville (2011), as previously amended, which allows the appointment of a resident of unincorporated Johnson County to be a member of the Library Board of Trustees, for 3rd and final consideration.

<u>Note</u>: This amends Chapter 22 of the Coralville Code of Ordinances to include a representative of Johnson County on the Library Board of Trustees which has been in practice since approved by a ballot measure in 2005.

Note: This is for the 4-story mixed use building with underground parking at 570 1st Avenue, which has increased the number of residential units from 39 to 51 since filing the original application.
